Sub: - Objection on issuance of fresh PO for 100No. of WAC for CMTS: reg.

Ref: My letter dtd.08.02.2011

Sir,

In supplementing to our request to cancel the PO for 100 No. of 2ton WAC for CMTS I do here by submit the stock position of ACs in your zone. That, there are **856No. of ACs laying idle** in stock as on date at various stores in Orissa. The officers find difficulty to store them because of unavailability of space. Out of these, 153 are 1.5ton WAC of reciprocating compressor type. Rest is Split AC of 1.5ton or 2ton.

Sir, in this context let me draw your judicious attention that now our BSNL is passing through a very crucial financial situation. BSNL HQ has also instructed all the officers to think very seriously before taking any expenditure whether it is fully justified. In this regard our organization has taken up a meeting with you when you pointed out that the CMTS has given the requisition to replace the less cooling ones which are more than 6years old. More over it was told to us that Split ACs cannot be fitted in the shelter.

But I along with my technical members visited one of the most packed shelter i.e. Pithapur in Cuttack. It is seen that 4No. of bays are installed for 3G and 2G. Bty P/P are there. We find enough space can be made to install two split ACs by sealing the WAC holes. One more split AC can also be installed in that room.

Sir, the WACs with your stock are **all of reciprocating compressor ones**. They are designed to run round the clock and cooling effect is very good. The present WACs fitted in the shelter are of rotary one and are of low cooling model. Also if we can arrange to install the split AC it will no doubt give better cooling and also can save electricity and it is free from fire hazard. When we have sufficient No. of spare ACs, we can manage the requirements if we sincerely think. And the expenditure in sealing the WAC holes etc. will be much less than purchasing new ones.

Moreover it is known that 26No. of high cooling 2ton Split ACs are laying idle in your Bolangir store that costs ` 90,00 each. It is of such high cooling that even one can manage the cooling of two WACs. It should also be kept in mind t6hat ACs are consumable items having a limited life. Even storing them reduces it.

In consideration of above, our organization strongly opposes the fresh purchase as the huge stock with your office is not utilized even though we have been bringing to your notice 6months before. More over, it is a departmental procedure that any financial involvement must pass through the IFA/section DFA. But it is known that your finance wing is ignorant of it. Certainly it invites Audit objections and Vigilance interference.
